6 (B) transportable in one or more sections;
7 (C) not constructed on a permanent chas-
8 sis; and
9 (D) designed to be used as a dwelling on
10 permanent foundations when connected to re-
11 quired utilities, including the plumbing, heating,
12 air conditioning, and electrical systems con-
13 tained therein.

1 (4) ENERGY STAR QUALIFIED MODULAR
2 HOME.—The term “Energy Star qualified modular
3 home” means a modular home that has been de-
4 signed, produced, and installed in accordance with
5 Energy Star’s guidelines.
