

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5114, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MR. HINCHEY OF NEW YORK**

Page 22, after line 25, insert the following new sections:

1 **SEC. 12. COMMUNITY OUTREACH PLAN FOR UPDATING**  
2 **FLOODPLAIN AREAS AND FLOOD-RISK**  
3 **ZONES.**

4 The Administrator of the Federal Emergency Man-  
5 agement Agency—

6 (1) shall, not later than the expiration of the  
7 60-day period beginning upon the date of the enact-  
8 ment of this Act, submit to the Congress a commu-  
9 nity outreach plan for the updating of floodplain  
10 areas and flood-risk zones under section 1360(f) of  
11 the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (42  
12 U.S.C. 4101(f)); and

13 (2) may not revise and update any floodplain  
14 area or flood-risk zone under such section 1360(f) of  
15 the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 until the  
16 date on which the Administrator submits such com-  
17 munity outreach plan.

1 **SEC. 13. NOTIFICATION OF ESTABLISHMENT OF FLOOD**  
2 **ELEVATIONS.**

3 Section 1360 of the National Flood Insurance Act of  
4 1968 (42 U.S.C. 4101) is amended by adding at the end  
5 the following new subsection:

6 “(1) NOTIFICATION TO MEMBERS OF CONGRESS OF  
7 MAP MODERNIZATION.—Upon any revision or update of  
8 any floodplain area or flood-risk zone pursuant to sub-  
9 section (f), any decision pursuant to subsection (f)(1) that  
10 such revision or update is necessary, any issuance of pre-  
11 liminary maps for such revision or updating, or any other  
12 significant action relating to any such revision or update,  
13 the Director shall notify the Senators for each State af-  
14 fected, and each Member of the House of Representatives  
15 for each congressional district affected, by such revision  
16 or update in writing of the action taken.”.
