

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5114, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MRS. BACHMANN OF MINNESOTA

Strike section 22 (relating to flood insurance advocate) and insert the following:

1 **SEC. 22. COST-EFFECTIVE CONSUMER PROTECTION.**

2 The Comptroller General of the United States shall
3 conduct a study to identify—

4 (1) common problems insureds under the na-
5 tional flood insurance program have in their inter-
6 actions with the Federal Emergency Management
7 Agency and any potential legislative, administrative,
8 or regulatory changes which may be appropriate to
9 mitigate such problems; and

10 (2) areas of the law or regulations relating to
11 the national flood insurance program that impose
12 significant compliance burdens on such insureds or
13 the Federal Emergency Management Agency and
14 specific recommendations for remedying such prob-
15 lems.

16 Not later than the expiration of the 12-month period be-
17 ginning on the date of the enactment of this Act, the
18 Comptroller General shall submit a report to the Congress

- 1 regarding the results and conclusions of the study under
- 2 this section.
