

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5116, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. BROUN OF GEORGIA**

Page 71, line 11, through page 75, line 9, amend section 212 to read as follows:

1 SEC. 212. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—There are authorized to be appro-
3 priated to the Foundation \$6,872,510,000 for each of the
4 fiscal years 2011 through 2013.

5 (b) SPECIFIC ALLOCATIONS.—Of the amount author-
6 ized under subsection (a) for each fiscal year—

7 (1) \$5,563,920,400 shall be made available for
8 research and related activities;

9 (2) \$872,760,000 shall be made available for
10 education and human resources;

11 (3) \$117,290,000 shall be made available for
12 major research equipment and facilities construction;

13 (4) \$300,000,000 shall be made available for
14 agency operations and award management;

15 (5) \$4,540,000 shall be made available for the
16 Office of the National Science Board; and

17 (6) \$14,000,000 shall be made available for the
18 Office of Inspector General.

Page 150, line 7, through page 155, line 25, amend section 402 to read as follows:

1 SEC. 402. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—There are authorized to be appro-
3 priated to the Secretary of Commerce \$856,600,000 for
4 the National Institute of Standards and Technology for
5 each of the fiscal years 2011 through 2013.

6 (b) SPECIFIC ALLOCATIONS.—Of the amount author-
7 ized under subsection (a) for each fiscal year—

8 (1) \$515,000,000 shall be authorized for sci-
9 entific and technical research and services laboratory
10 activities;

11 (2) \$120,000,000 shall be authorized for the
12 construction and maintenance of facilities; and

13 (3) \$194,600,000 shall be authorized for indus-
14 trial technology services activities, of which—

15 (A) \$70,000,000 shall be authorized for
16 the Technology Innovation Program under sec-
17 tion 28 of the National Institute of Standards
18 and Technology Act (15 U.S.C. 278n);

1 (B) \$124,700,000 shall be authorized for
2 the Manufacturing Extension Partnership pro-
3 gram under sections 25 and 26 of such Act (15
4 U.S.C. 278k and 278l); and

5 (C) \$9,600,000 shall be authorized for the
6 Malcolm Baldrige National Quality Award pro-
7 gram under section 17 of the Stevenson-Wydler
8 Technology Innovation Act of 1980 (15 U.S.C.
9 3711a).

Page 225, line 1, through page 227, line 3, amend
section 611 to read as follows:

10 **SEC. 611. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

11 There are authorized to be appropriated to the Sec-
12 retary for the activities of the Office of Science
13 \$4,904,000,000 for each of the fiscal years 2011 through
14 2013, of which for each fiscal year—

15 (1) \$1,637,000,000 shall be for Basic Energy
16 Sciences activities under section 604;

17 (2) \$604,000,000 shall be for Biological and
18 Environmental Research activities under section
19 605; and

1 (3) \$394,000,000 shall be for Advanced Sci-
2 entific Computing Research activities under section
3 606.

Page 234, lines 16 through 24, amend paragraph
(2) to read as follows:

4 “(2) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—
5 Subject to paragraph (4), there are authorized to be
6 appropriated to the Director for deposit in the
7 Fund, without fiscal year limitation, \$15,000,000
8 for each of the fiscal years 2011 through 2013.”.
