

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5116, AS REPORTED**  
**OFFERED BY MR. SESSIONS OF TEXAS**

Page 71, line 11, through page 75, line 9, amend  
section 212 to read as follows:

**1 SEC. 212. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—There are authorized to be appro-  
3 priated to the Foundation \$7,481,000,000 for each of the  
4 fiscal years 2011 through 2015.

5 (b) SPECIFIC ALLOCATIONS.—Of the amount author-  
6 ized under subsection (a) for each fiscal year—

7 (1) \$6,020,000,000 shall be made available for  
8 research and related activities;

9 (2) \$945,000,000 shall be made available for  
10 education and human resources;

11 (3) \$166,000,000 shall be made available for  
12 major research equipment and facilities construction;

13 (4) \$330,000,000 shall be made available for  
14 agency operations and award management;

15 (5) \$4,840,000 shall be made available for the  
16 Office of the National Science Board; and

17 (6) \$14,830,000 shall be made available for the  
18 Office of Inspector General.

Page 145, line 9, strike “section” and all that follows through line 14 and insert “section \$30,000,000 for each of the fiscal years 2011 through 2015.”

Page 150, line 7, through page 155, line 25, amend section 402 to read as follows:

**1 SEC. 402. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—There are authorized to be appro-  
3 priated to the Secretary of Commerce \$991,100,000 for  
4 the National Institute of Standards and Technology for  
5 each of the fiscal years 2011 through 2015.

6 (b) SPECIFIC ALLOCATIONS.—Of the amount author-  
7 ized under subsection (a) for each fiscal year—

8 (1) \$620,000,000 shall be authorized for sci-  
9 entific and technical research and services laboratory  
10 activities;

11 (2) \$125,000,000 shall be authorized for the  
12 construction and maintenance of facilities; and

13 (3) \$246,100,000 shall be authorized for indus-  
14 trial technology services activities, of which—

15 (A) \$95,000,000 shall be authorized for  
16 the Technology Innovation Program under sec-  
17 tion 28 of the National Institute of Standards  
18 and Technology Act (15 U.S.C. 278n);

19 (B) \$141,100,000 shall be authorized for  
20 the Manufacturing Extension Partnership pro-

1           gram under sections 25 and 26 of such Act (15  
2           U.S.C. 278k and 278l); and  
3           (C) \$10,000,000 shall be authorized for  
4           the Malcolm Baldrige National Quality Award  
5           program under section 17 of the Stevenson-  
6           Wylder Technology Innovation Act of 1980 (15  
7           U.S.C. 3711a).

Page 225, line 1, through page 227, line 3, amend  
section 611 to read as follows:

8 **SEC. 611. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

9           There are authorized to be appropriated to the Sec-  
10          retary for the activities of the Office of Science  
11          \$5,247,000,000 for each of the fiscal years 2011 through  
12          2015, of which for each fiscal year—

13               (1) \$1,875,000,000 shall be for Basic Energy  
14          Sciences activities under section 604;

15               (2) \$667,000,000 shall be for Biological and  
16          Environmental Research activities under section  
17          605; and

18               (3) \$466,000,000 shall be for Advanced Sci-  
19          entific Computing Research activities under section  
20          606.

Page 234, lines 16 through 24, amend paragraph  
(2) to read as follows:

1           “(2) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—  
2           Subject to paragraph (4), there are authorized to be  
3           appropriated to the Director for deposit in the  
4           Fund, without fiscal year limitation, \$300,000,000  
5           for each of the fiscal years 2011 through 2015.”.

Page 243, strike line 21 and all that follows through  
page 244, line 1, and insert the following: “this section  
\$110,000,000 for each of the fiscal years 2011 through  
2015.”.
