

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5136, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. BURTON OF INDIANA**

Page 167, after line 20, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 547. PROCEDURES FOR PROTECTING THE IDENTITY**
2 **OF MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES**
3 **CHARGED WITH MISTREATMENT OF SUS-**
4 **PECTED TERRORISTS.**

5 The Secretary of Defense and Attorney General shall
6 jointly establish procedures and regulations designed to
7 ensure that in the event that a member of the Armed
8 Forces is accused and formally charged with mistreatment
9 of a person suspected of committing an act of terrorism—

10 (1) the identity of the member will be withheld
11 from public record;

12 (2) the proceedings of any court that hears any
13 case or motion relating to the trial of the member
14 for such mistreatment will remain sealed to protect
15 the safety of the service member and their family
16 during the trial process; and

17 (3) if the member is cleared of all charges relat-
18 ing to such alleged mistreatment, the documents re-
19 lating to such proceedings will remain sealed to per-

1 mit the member to return to service in an expedi-
2 tious fashion.
