Page 92, after line 24, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 326. CONVERSION OF FUNCTIONS FROM CONTRACTOR**
2 **PERFORMANCE TO PERFORMANCE BY FED-**
3 **ERAL EMPLOYEES.**

4 (a) **DECISION TO INSOURCE.—**

5 (1) **IN GENERAL.—**The Director of the Office of
6 Management and Budget may not establish any nu-
7 merical goal, target, or quota for the conversion of
8 any function from contractor performance to per-
9 formance by Federal employees unless such goal,
10 target or quota is based on considered research and
11 analysis.

12 (2) **EXCEPTION.—**Paragraph (1) shall not
13 apply to the Department of Defense.

14 (b) **REPORTS.—**

15 (1) **REPORT TO CONGRESS.—**Not later than De-
16 cember 31 of 2010, and of each subsequent year
17 through 2014, the Director of the Office of Manage-
18 ment and Budget shall submit to the Committee on
19 Oversight and Government Reform of the House of
20 Representatives and the Committee on Homeland

1 Security and Governmental Affairs of the Senate a
2 report on agency decisions made during the fiscal
3 year covered by the report with respect to the con-
4 version of functions from performance by a con-
5 tractor to performance by Federal employees. Such
6 report shall include—

7 (A) a summary of the agency decisions for
8 converting to Federal employee performance;

9 (B) the basis and rationale for the agency
10 decisions; and

11 (C) the number of contractor employees
12 whose functions were converted to performance
13 by Federal employees.

14 (2) COMPTROLLER GENERAL REVIEW.—Not
15 later than 120 days after the submittal of a report
16 under paragraph (1), the Comptroller General of the
17 United States shall submit to the Committee on
18 Oversight and Government Reform of the House of
19 Representatives and the Committee on Homeland
20 Security and Governmental Affairs of the Senate an
21 assessment of the report.

22 (3) EXCEPTION.—Nothing in this subsection
23 shall apply to reports submitted by the Secretary of
24 Defense.
