

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5136, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MRS. DAHLKEMPER OF
PENNSYLVANIA

Page 122, after line 18, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 359. AUTHORITY TO MAKE EXCESS NONLETHAL SUP-**
2 **PLIES AVAILABLE FOR DOMESTIC EMER-**
3 **GENCY ASSISTANCE.**

4 (a) **DOMESTIC AUTHORITY.**—Section 2557 of title
5 10, United States Code, is amended—

6 (1) in subsection (a)(1), by adding at the end
7 the following new sentence: “In addition, the Sec-
8 retary may make nonlethal excess supplies of the
9 Department available to support domestic emergency
10 assistance activities.”; and

11 (2) in subsection (b)—

12 (A) by inserting “(1)” before “Excess”;

13 and

14 (B) by adding at the end the following new
15 paragraph:

16 “(2) Excess supplies made available under this sec-
17 tion to support domestic emergency assistance activities
18 shall be transferred to the Secretary of Homeland Secu-
19 rity. The Secretary of Defense may provide assistance in

1 the distribution of such supplies at the request of the Sec-
2 retary of Homeland Security.”.

3 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENTS.—

4 (1) SECTION HEADING.—The heading of such
5 section is amended to read as follows:

6 “§ 2557. **Excess nonlethal supplies: availability for hu-**
7 **manitarian relief, domestic emergency**
8 **assistance, and homeless veterans assist-**
9 **ance”.**

10 (2) TABLE OF SECTIONS.—The item relating to
11 such section in the table of sections at the beginning
12 of chapter 152 of such title is amended to read as
13 follows:

“2557. Excess nonlethal supplies: availability for humanitarian relief, domestic
emergency assistance, and homeless veterans assistance.”.
