SUSPENSION OF ADMINISTRATIVE SEPARATIONS OF MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES FOR PERSONALITY DISORDER.

Effective as of the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of a military department may not discharge from the Armed Forces for personality disorder any member of the Armed Forces (including a member of the National Guard or Reserve) who has served on active duty in a combat zone. The limitation shall not apply with respect to any member of the Armed Forces who provided false or misleading information, or omitted providing information about past criminal behavior, that is material to a discharge for personality disorder during recruitment for or enlistment in the Armed Forces.
