

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5136, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. REICHERT OF WASHINGTON**

At the end of subtitle A of title XXVIII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 28__ . CONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION, AND REPAIR**
2 **ASSISTANCE FOR PUBLICLY OPERATED**
3 **SCHOOLS LOCATED ON MILITARY INSTALLA-**
4 **TIONS.**

5 (a) ASSISTANCE TO PUBLICLY OPERATED SCHOOLS
6 LOCATED ON MILITARY INSTALLATIONS.—Using amounts
7 made available pursuant to subsection (d), the Secretary
8 of Defense shall provide assistance to local educational
9 agencies to construct, modernize, renovate, or substan-
10 tially repair publicly operated elementary or secondary
11 schools that—

12 (1) are (or, in the case of new construction, will
13 be) located on military installations in the United
14 States; and

15 (2) serve (or will serve) dependents of members
16 of the Armed Forces and Department of Defense ci-
17 vilian employees.

18 (b) IDENTIFICATION OF SCHOOLS REQUIRING AS-
19 SISTANCE.—Not later than March 31, 2011. the Secretary

1 of Defense, after consultation with local education agen-
2 cies, shall submit to the congressional defense committees
3 a list of the schools to be constructed, modernized, ren-
4 ovated, or repaired using the funds made available under
5 subsection (d) and a list of any urgent unfunded require-
6 ments.

7 (c) LOCAL EDUCATIONAL AGENCY DEFINED.—In
8 this section, the term “local educational agency” has the
9 meaning given that term in section 8013(9) of the Ele-
10 mentary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C.
11 7713(9)).

12 (d) FUNDING SOURCE.—Of the amount authorized to
13 be appropriated in section 2401(c)(1) for military con-
14 struction projects for the Defense Agencies inside the
15 United States, \$100,000,000 shall be available only to
16 provide assistance under subsection (a). Amounts made
17 available under this subsection shall remain available until
18 expended.
