

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5136, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. SCHRADER OF OREGON**

Page 266, after line 8, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 706. PROVISION OF INFORMATION TO MEMBERS OF**
2 **THE RESERVE COMPONENTS REGARDING**
3 **HEALTH CARE BENEFITS.**

4 (a) **PROVISION OF INFORMATION.**—The Secretary of
5 Defense shall ensure that each member of a reserve com-
6 ponent of the Armed Forces who is mobilized or demobi-
7 lized is provided, together with the orders providing for
8 such mobilization or demobilization, a clear and com-
9 prehensive statement of the medical care and treatment
10 to which such member is entitled under Federal law by
11 reason of being so mobilized or demobilized.

12 (b) **FREQUENCY.**—The statement required to be pro-
13 vided a member under subsection (a) upon a mobilization
14 or demobilization shall be provided to the member each
15 time the member is mobilized or demobilized, as the case
16 may be.

17 (c) **ELEMENTS.**—The statement provided a member
18 under subsection (a) shall include the following:

19 (1) A clear, comprehensive statement of the
20 medical care and treatment to which the member is

1 entitled under Federal law by reason of being mobi-
2 lized or demobilized, as applicable, including—

3 (A) the nature and range of the care and
4 treatment to which the member is entitled;

5 (B) the departments and agencies of the
6 Federal Government that will provide such care
7 and treatment;

8 (C) the period for which such care and
9 treatment will be so provided; and

10 (D) the obligations, if any, of the member
11 in connection with the receipt of such care and
12 treatment.

13 (2) A clear, comprehensive statement of the
14 health care insurance available under Federal law
15 for the member's family, if any, by reason of the
16 mobilization or demobilization of the member.

17 (3) A clear, comprehensive description of the
18 mental health assessments available to the member
19 before, during, and after deployment pursuant to
20 section 708 of the national defense authorization act
21 for fiscal year 2010 (public law 11184; 123 Stat.
22 2376; 10U.S.C. 1074f note).

23 (4) Such other matters as the Secretary con-
24 siders appropriate.
