

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5136, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. SCHRADER OF OREGON**

Page 219, after line 5, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 599. STUDY OF TREATMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE RE-**
2 **SERVE COMPONENTS.**

3 (a) STUDY.—The Inspector General of the Depart-
4 ment of Defense shall conduct a study of the treatment
5 of members of the reserve components.

6 (b) MATTERS INCLUDED.—The study under sub-
7 section (a) shall include the following:

8 (1) An analysis of the treatment of members of
9 the reserve components—

10 (A) at mobilization and demobilization
11 sites of the Army, including warrior transition
12 units and joint medical battalions; and

13 (B) during predeployment and
14 postdeployment medical examinations under
15 section 1074(f) of title 10, United States Code.

16 (2) An analysis of the quality of care, treat-
17 ment, and information that members of the reserve
18 components receive before, during, and after deploy-
19 ment.

1 (3) An analysis of patterns of treatment of
2 members of the reserve components during the pe-
3 riod following a deployment, including during med-
4 ical examinations or other actions that could affect
5 health care and disability benefits, as compared to
6 the treatment of members of the regular components
7 during such period.

8 (4) Identification of any improvements needed
9 so that members of the reserve components and
10 members of the regular components are treated
11 equally.

12 (c) REPORT.—Not later than December 31, 2010, the
13 Inspector General shall submit to the congressional de-
14 fense committees a report on the study under subsection
15 (a).
