

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5136, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MR. TURNER OF OHIO**

**(Amendment offered for himself, Mr. Lamborn of Colorado,  
and Mr. Kirk of Illinois)**

Page 60, strike lines 9 through 13 and insert the following:

1           (2) field missile defenses in Europe that provide  
2           protection of the United States against interconti-  
3           nental ballistic missile threats by no later than the  
4           time such threats are assessed to materialize, pursu-  
5           ant to the National Missile Defense Act of 1999  
6           (Public Law 106-38; 10 U.S.C. 2431 note), and to  
7           test those systems in an operationally realistic man-  
8           ner;

Page 60, line 21, strike “and”.

Page 61, line 17, strike the period and insert “;  
and”.

Page 61, after line 17, insert the following:

9           (5) maintain and refurbish Missile Field 1 at  
10          Fort Greely, Alaska, as a further means of protec-  
11          tion for the United States against the increasing  
12          threat of long-range ballistic missiles.

1 (c) PROHIBITION.—Paragraph (1) of section 233(b)  
2 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year  
3 2010 (Public Law 111–84; 123 Stat. 2234) is amended  
4 to read as follows:

5 “(1) PROHIBITION ON DECOMMISSIONING OF  
6 MISSILE FIELD 1.—The Secretary of Defense shall  
7 ensure that Missile Field 1 at Fort Greely, Alaska,  
8 is—

9 “(A) maintained and refurbished; and

10 “(B) not decommissioned.”.
