

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5175, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. HARPER OF MISSISSIPPI**

Page 24, strike lines 3 through 25 and insert the following:

1 (c) TRANSITION RULE FOR ACTIONS TAKEN PRIOR
2 TO EFFECTIVE DATE.—No person shall be considered to
3 have made a payment for a coordinated communication
4 under section 324 of the Federal Election Campaign Act
5 of 1971 (as amended by subsection (b)) by reason of any
6 action taken by the person prior to the effective date of
7 this Act. Nothing in the previous sentence shall be con-
8 strued to affect any determination under any other provi-
9 sion of such Act which is in effect on the effective date
10 of this Act regarding whether a communication is made
11 in cooperation, consultation, or concert with, or at the re-
12 quest or suggestion of, a candidate, an authorized com-
13 mittee of a candidate, or a political committee of a political
14 party.

Page 26, strike lines 13 through 19.

Page 29, strike line 18 and all that follows through
page 30, line 4 and insert the following:

1 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE FOR REPORTING REQUIRE-
2 MENTS.—The amendment made by subsection (b) shall
3 apply with respect to reports required to be filed after the
4 effective date of this Act.

Page 30, strike line 22 and all that follows through
page 31, line 10 and insert the following:

5 (c) TRANSITION FOR COMMUNICATIONS MADE PRIOR
6 TO EFFECTIVE DATE.—No communication which is made
7 prior to the effective date of this Act shall be treated as
8 an electioneering communication under section
9 304(f)(3)(A)(i)(II) of the Federal Election Campaign Act
10 of 1971 (as amended by subsection (a)) unless the commu-
11 nication would be treated as an electioneering communica-
12 tion under such section if the amendment made by sub-
13 section (a) did not apply.

Page 84, line 11, strike “that begin after the date
of the enactment of this Act” and insert “that begin on
or after the effective date of this Act”.

Page 90, strike lines 5 through 11 and insert the
following:

1 **SEC. 403. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2 Except as otherwise provided, this Act and the
3 amendments made by this Act shall take effect January
4 1, 2011.
