**AMENDMENT TO H.R. \_\_\_\_\_, AS REPORTED**  
**(ENERGY & WATER APPROPRIATIONS)**  
**OFFERED BY MR. MURPHY OF CONNECTICUT**

At the end of the bill (before the short title), insert the following:

1       SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. REINSTATEMENT AND TRANSFER OF  
2 CERTAIN HYDROELECTRIC LICENSES.— (a) EXTENSION  
3 OF TIME AND REINSTATEMENT OF EXPIRED LI-  
4 CENSES.—Notwithstanding the time period specified in  
5 section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that  
6 would otherwise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory  
7 Commission projects numbered 10822 and 10823, the  
8 Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (referred to in  
9 this section as the “Commission”) shall, upon the enact-  
10 ment of this Act—

11           (1) reinstate the licenses effective as of the date  
12       of their termination; and

13           (2) extend the time period during which the li-  
14       censee is required to commence the construction of  
15       each project to and including February 23, 2011.

16       (b) TRANSFER OF LICENSES.—Notwithstanding sec-  
17       tion 8 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 801) or any  
18       other provision thereof, the Commission is directed to

1 transfer the licenses for Federal Energy Regulatory Com-  
2 mission projects numbered 10822 and 10823, without  
3 delay or the institution of any proceedings, to the Town  
4 of Canton, Connecticut, not later than 30 days after the  
5 date of the enactment of this Act.
