

**AMENDMENT TO THE ENERGY AND WATER
APPROPRIATIONS BILL, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. UPTON OF MICHIGAN**

Page 58, after line 13, insert the following new section:

1 SEC. 313. The Secretary of Energy shall, in consulta-
2 tion with the Secretary of Labor, beginning not later than
3 six months after the date of enactment of this Act and
4 on a biannual basis thereafter, provide a report to the
5 Committees on Appropriations of the House of Represent-
6 atives and the Senate that, with respect to the enactment
7 or implementation of the American Clean Energy and Se-
8 curity Act of 2009 (H.R. 2454 of the 111th Congress),
9 or substantially similar legislation—

10 (1) details the number of jobs created or lost,
11 both within the previous six month time period and
12 in the aggregate, as a result of such Act;

13 (2) classifies whether those jobs are permanent
14 or temporary; and

15 (3) identifies sectors of the job market that
16 have experienced a growth or decline in employment
17 as a result of such Act.
