**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2200, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. LYNCH OF MASSACHUSETTS**

In section 239 of the bill, strike subsections (a) and
insert the following:

1 (a) USE OF PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT.—

2 (1) IN GENERAL.—Any personnel of the Trans-
3 portation Security Administration voluntarily may
4 wear personal protective equipment during any
5 emergency.

6 (2) WRITTEN GUIDANCE.—Not later than 90
7 days after the date of enactment of this Act, the
8 Secretary of Homeland Security shall establish, co-
9 ordinate, and disseminate written guidance to per-
10 sonnel of the Transportation Security Administra-
11 tion to allow for the voluntary usage of personal pro-
12 tective equipment.

13 (3) DEFINITION.—In this subsection, the term
14 “personal protective equipment” includes surgical
15 and N95 masks, gloves, and hand sanitizer.
