**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2647, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. CONNOLLY OF VIRGINIA, MR.
NYE OF VIRGINIA, AND MR. PERRIELLO OF
VIRGINIA**

Page 163, line 11, strike "service," and insert the following: "service (including a contract to which the servicemember is included with family members),".

At the end of subtitle I of title V (page 180, after line 11), add the following new section:

**1 SEC. 594. MODIFICATION OF SERVICEMEMBERS CIVIL RE-
2 LIEF ACT REGARDING RESIDENTIAL AND
3 MOTOR VEHICLE LEASES.**

4 Section 305(e) of the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act
5 (50 U.S.C. App. 535) is amended to read as follows:

6 "(e) ARREARAGES AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS AND
7 LIABILITIES.—

8 "(1) LEASES OF PREMISES.—Rent amounts for
9 a lease described in subsection (b)(1) that are un-
10 paid for the period preceding the effective date of
11 the lease termination shall be paid on a prorated
12 basis. The lessor may not impose an early termi-
13 nation charge, but any taxes, summonses, or other

1 obligations and liabilities of the lessee in accordance
2 with the terms of the lease, including reasonable
3 charges to the lessee for excess wear, that are due
4 and unpaid at the time of termination of the lease
5 shall be paid by the lessee.

6 “(2) LEASES OF MOTOR VEHICLES.—Lease
7 amounts for a lease described in subsection (b)(2)
8 that are unpaid for the period preceding the effective
9 date of the lease termination shall be paid on a pro-
10 rated basis. The lessor may not impose an early ter-
11 mination charge, but any taxes, summonses, title
12 and registration fees, or other obligations and liabil-
13 ities of the lessee in accordance with the terms of
14 the lease, including reasonable charges to the lessee
15 for excess wear or use and mileage, that are due and
16 unpaid at the time of termination of the lease shall
17 be paid by the lessee.”.
