AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2701, AS REPORTED

OFFERED BY MR. CONAWAY of Texas

Page 87, strike line 21 and all that follows through page 88, line 9, and insert the following:

1 (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con-
2 gress that—

3 (1) it is imperative that intelligence community-
4 wide auditability be achieved as soon as possible;

5 (2) the Business Transformation Office of the
6 Office of the Director of National Intelligence has
7 made substantial progress and must be of sufficient
8 standing within the Office of the Director of Na-
9 tional Intelligence to move the plan for core financial
10 system requirements to reach intelligence commu-
11 nity-wide auditability forward;

12 (3) as of the date of the enactment of this Act,
13 the National Reconnaissance Office is the only ele-
14 ment of the intelligence community to have received
15 a clean audit; and

16 (4) the National Reconnaissance Office should
17 be commended for the long hours and hard work in-
18 vested by the Office to achieve a clean audit.
