**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3246, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MR. GORDON OF TENNESSEE**

Page 15, after line 9, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 105. REPORTING.**

2 Not later than 18 months after the date of enactment  
3 of this Act and annually thereafter through 2015, the Sec-  
4 retary of Energy shall transmit to Congress a report re-  
5 garding the technologies developed as a result of the ac-  
6 tivities authorized by this title, with a particular emphasis  
7 on whether the technologies were successfully adopted for  
8 commercial applications, and if so, whether those tech-  
9 nologies are manufactured in the United States.

Page 18, line 20, through page 19, line 2, amend subsection (c) to read as follows:

10 (c) REPORTING.—At the end of each fiscal year, the  
11 Secretary shall submit to the Congress an annual report  
12 describing activities undertaken in the previous year, ac-  
13 tive industry participants, efforts to recruit new partici-  
14 pants, progress of the program in meeting goals and  
15 timelines, and a strategic plan for funding of activities  
16 across agencies.

Page 20, line 13, strike "heavy duty".

Page 20, line 13, insert "mobile" after "nonroad".
