**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5013, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. KISSELL OF NORTH CAROLINA**

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 **TITLE V—OTHER MATTERS**

2 **SEC. 501. CLOTHING ALLOWANCE REQUIREMENT.**

3 The Comptroller General shall conduct a study of the
4 items purchased under section 418 of title 37, United
5 States Code, to determine if there is sufficient domestic
6 production of such items to adequately supply members
7 of the Armed Forces and shall transmit the results of such
8 study to the Secretary of Defense. Not later than 6
9 months after receiving the results of such study, the Sec-
10 retary of Defense shall transmit to the Committees on
11 Armed Services of the Senate and the House of Represent-
12 atives an evaluation on whether such items under the
13 study should be considered subject to section 2533a of
14 title 10, United States Code (popularly known as the
15 “Berry Amendment”).
