The Committee on Rules, having had under consideration House Resolution____, by a nonrecord vote, report the same to the House with the recommendation that the resolution be adopted.

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS OF THE RESOLUTION

The resolution provides for consideration of H.R. 2087, to remove restrictions from a parcel of land situated in the Atlantic District, Accomack County, Virginia, under a modified open rule. The resolution provides one hour of general debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on Natural Resources. The resolution waives all points of order against consideration of the bill. The resolution makes in order the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Natural Resources now printed in the bill as original text for purpose of amendment and provides that it shall be considered as read. The resolution waives all points of order against the amendment in the nature of a substitute. The resolution makes in order only those amendments that are submitted for printing in the Congressional Record dated March 19, 2012, or pro forma amendments for the purpose of debate. Each amendment submitted for printing in the Congressional Record may be offered only by the member who submitted it for printing or the Member's designee and shall be considered as read if printed. Finally, the resolution provides one motion to recommit with or without instructions.

EXPLANATION OF WAIVERS

Although the resolution waives all points of order against consideration of the bill, the Committee is not aware of any points of order. The waiver is prophylactic in nature.

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2087) to remove restrictions from a parcel of land situated in the Atlantic District, Accomack County, Virginia.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the State of the Union for consid-
5 eration of the bill (H.R. 2087) to remove restrictions from
6 a parcel of land situated in the Atlantic District,

1 Accomack County, Virginia. The first reading of the bill
2 shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consid-
3 eration of the bill are waived. General debate shall be con-
4 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-
5 vided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
6 member of the Committee on Natural Resources. After
7 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
8 under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider
9 as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under
10 the five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a sub-
11 stitute recommended by the Committee on Natural Re-
12 sources now printed in the bill. The committee amendment
13 in the nature of a substitute shall be considered as read.
14 All points of order against the committee amendment in
15 the nature of a substitute are waived. No amendment to
16 the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute
17 shall be in order except those received for printing in the
18 portion of the Congressional Record designated for that
19 purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII in a daily issue dated
20 March 19, 2012, and except pro forma amendments for
21 the purpose of debate. Each amendment so received may
22 be offered only by the Member who caused it to be printed
23 or a designee and shall be considered as read if printed.
24 At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for amend-
25 ment the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the

1 House with such amendments as may have been adopted.
2 Any Member may demand a separate vote in the House
3 on any amendment adopted in the Committee of the Whole
4 to the bill or to the committee amendment in the nature
5 of a substitute. The previous question shall be considered
6 as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final
7 passage without intervening motion except one motion to
8 recommit with or without instructions.
