**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1309, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MR. LUETKEMEYER OF MISSOURI**

Page 70, after line 5, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 27. REPORT ON FLOOD-IN-PROGRESS DETERMINA-**  
2 **TION.**

3 The Administrator of the Federal Emergency Man-  
4 agement Agency shall review the processes and procedures  
5 for determining that a flood event has commenced or is  
6 in progress for purposes of flood insurance coverage made  
7 available under the national flood insurance program  
8 under the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 and for  
9 providing public notification that such an event has com-  
10 menced or is in progress. In such review, the Adminis-  
11 trator shall take into consideration the effects and implica-  
12 tions that weather conditions, such as rainfall, snowfall,  
13 projected snowmelt, existing water levels, and other condi-  
14 tions have on the determination that a flood event has  
15 commenced or is in progress. Not later than the expiration  
16 of the 6-month period beginning upon the date of the en-  
17 actment of this Act, the Administrator shall submit a re-  
18 port to the Congress setting forth the results and conclu-  
19 sions of the review undertaken pursuant to this section

1 and any actions undertaken or proposed actions to be  
2 taken to provide for a more precise and technical deter-  
3 mination that a flooding event has commenced or is in  
4 progress.
