After section 2, insert the following:

1 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE CONDITIONS.

2 Notwithstanding sections 104, 105, 110, and 111 and
3 title III, nothing in this Act or the amendments made by
4 this Act shall take effect until the Secretary of the Inte-
5 rior, in consultation with the Secretary of Agriculture, the
6 Secretary of Commerce, and the Secretary of Labor, cer-
7 tifies that the provisions of this Act and the amendments
8 made by this Act will not result in the loss of agriculture,
9 agriculture-related, fishery, or fishery-related jobs or rev-
10 enue in California counties north of the Sacramento-San
11 Joaquin River Delta.
