**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3309, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. CROWLEY OF NEW YORK**

Page 7, line 5, strike “and”.

Page 7, line 15, strike the period and insert “; and”.

Page 7, after line 15, insert the following:

1 “(F) in the case of the adoption of a rule
2 or the amendment of an existing rule relating
3 to baby monitors, such rule as adopted or
4 amended requires the packaging of an analog
5 baby monitor to display a warning label stating
6 that sounds or images captured by the baby
7 monitor may be easily viewed or heard by po-
8 tential intruders outside a consumer’s home.
