

MOTION TO RECOMMIT H.J. RES. 117**OFFERED BY M**__ . _____

M__ . _____ moves to recommit the joint resolution H.J. Res. 117 to the Committee on Appropriations with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendment:

At the end of the joint resolution (before the short title), insert the following:

1 SEC. 156. (a) FULL YEAR FUNDING FOR MILITARY
2 PERSONNEL ACCOUNTS.—Notwithstanding section 106,
3 appropriations and funds made available and authority
4 granted pursuant to this joint resolution (including section
5 101(c)) for the following accounts of the Department of
6 Defense shall remain available until September 30, 2013:

- 7 (1) “Military Personnel, Army”.
- 8 (2) “Military Personnel, Navy”.
- 9 (3) “Military Personnel, Marine Corps”.
- 10 (4) “Military Personnel, Air Force”.
- 11 (5) “Reserve Personnel, Army”.
- 12 (6) “Reserve Personnel, Navy”.
- 13 (7) “Reserve Personnel, Marine Corps”.
- 14 (8) “Reserve Personnel, Air Force”.

1 (9) “National Guard Personnel, Army”.

2 (10) “National Guard Personnel, Air Force”.

3 (b) PERFORMANCE OF MEDICAL DISABILITY EXAMI-
4 NATIONS BY CONTRACT PHYSICIANS.—The authority pro-
5 vided by section 704 of the Veterans Benefits Act of 2003
6 (38 U.S.C. 5101 note) shall continue in effect through the
7 date specified in section 106(3) of this joint resolution.

8 (c) TREATMENT OF HOMELESS AND SERIOUSLY
9 MENTALLY ILL VETERANS.—The authority provided by
10 section 2031 of title 38, United States Code, shall con-
11 tinue in effect through the date specified in section 106(3)
12 of this joint resolution.

13 (d) ADDITIONAL SERVICES FOR HOMELESS AND SE-
14 RIOUSLY MENTALLY ILL VETERANS.—The authority pro-
15 vided by section 2033 of title 38, United States Code, shall
16 continue in effect through the date specified in section
17 106(3) of this joint resolution.
