

MOTION TO RECOMMIT WITH INSTRUCTIONS

_____ moves to recommit the bill H.R. 1938 to the Committee on Energy and Commerce with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith, with the following amendments:

Page 6, after line 24, insert the following new paragraphs:

1 (18) TransCanada Corporation has threatened
2 to condemn the land of American farmers, ranchers,
3 and homeowners along the Keystone XL pipeline
4 route, and farmers, ranchers, and homeowners in
5 the States of Montana, Nebraska, Oklahoma, South
6 Dakota, Kansas, and Texas are at risk of having
7 their property seized by a foreign corporation.

8 (19) In its permit application to the Canadian
9 Government, TransCanada Corporation, the owner
10 and operator of the Keystone XL pipeline, projected
11 that the Keystone XL pipeline will increase oil prices
12 in PADD 2, which includes the States of Illinois, In-
13 diana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Michigan, Min-
14 nesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Ohio,
15 Oklahoma, South Dakota, Tennessee, and Wis-

1 consin, increasing annual revenue to Canadian oil
2 producers by an estimated \$2,000,000,000 to
3 \$3,900,000,000 in 2013.

Page 7, lines 14 and 20, redesignate subsections (c)
and (d) as subsections (d) and (e), respectively.

Page 7, after line 13, insert the following new sub-
section:

4 (c) PROTECTING CONSUMERS FROM UNFAIR GAS
5 PRICE INCREASES AND SEIZURE OF FARMLAND.—The
6 President shall ensure that the necessary actions under
7 subsection (a) shall include—
8 (1) any feasible step to prevent an increase in
9 gasoline prices in any region of the country; and
10 (2) any feasible step to limit the seizure of
11 American farmland and ranchland without consent
12 of the landowners.
