Page 17, strike lines 3 through 12.

Page 17, line 13, strike “(3)” and insert “(2)”.

Page 17, line 14, strike “subsection” and insert “subsections”.

Page 17, line 17, after “decision” insert “concerning renewal, transfer or reissuance of a grazing permit or lease”.

Page 17, line 18, before the first period insert “or appeal officer as applicable”.

Page 18, strike lines 7 through 10 and insert “existing permit or lease.”.

Page 20, line 15, after “the” insert “applicable”.

Page 20, line 15, strike “and” and insert “or”.

Page 20, strike line 22 through page 21, line 4, and insert the following:

1 “(g) ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEWS.—

1 “(1) The Secretary concerned, in the sole dis-
2 cretion of the Secretary concerned, shall determine
3 the priority and timing for completing required envi-
4 ronmental reviews regarding any grazing allotment,
5 permit, or lease based on the environmental signifi-
6 cance of the allotment, permit, or lease and available
7 funding for that purpose.

8 “(2) The Secretary concerned shall seek to con-
9 duct environmental reviews on an allotment or mul-
10 tiple allotment basis, to the extent practicable, for
11 purposes of compliance with the National Environ-
12 mental Policy Act of 1969 (42 U.S.C. 4321 et seq.)
13 and other applicable laws.

Page 21, line 12, after the first period, insert the
following

14 “(i) TEMPORARY TRAILING AND CROSSING.—

15 “(1) Any application for temporary trailing or
16 crossing that has been submitted in a timely manner
17 or not less than 30 days prior to the anticipated
18 trailing or crossing shall be granted, modified or de-
19 nied not less than fifteen days prior to the date of
20 requested crossing or trailing. The minimum times
21 specified in this subsection shall not preclude the ap-
22 proval of an application in a shorter time where an
23 immediate need exists.

1 “(2) Temporary trailing or crossing authoriza-
2 tions across lands administered by the Bureau of
3 Land Management or the Forest Service system of
4 lands shall not be subject to protest or appeal except
5 by the applicant or an affected permittee or lessee.
