**AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT

Add at the end the following:

1 **SEC. 6. FINDINGS; SENSE OF CONGRESS.**

2 (a) FINDINGS.—The Congress finds the following:

3 (1) “The Congress acknowledges and honors  
4 the tremendous work of the Bureau of Consumer Fi-  
5 nancial Protection in protecting and providing relief  
6 to consumers from instances of unfair, deceptive,  
7 and abusive practices in financial markets.

8 (2) The Bureau of Consumer Financial Protec-  
9 tion has refunded over \$3 billion to approximately  
10 9.7 million victims of deceptive or abusive practices  
11 in financial markets since its inception.

12 (3) The Bureau of Consumer Financial Protec-  
13 tion has continued to engage with consumers, indus-  
14 try, Congress, and other regulators to promulgate  
15 rules making U.S. financial markets the fairest,  
16 safest, and most robust in the world.

17 (4) Changes to the current management, over-  
18 sight, or funding of the Bureau of Consumer Finan-

1        cial Protection would undermine the mission of the  
2        Bureau.

3        (b) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of the  
4        Congress that the Congress—

5            (1) acknowledges the meritorious work of the  
6        Bureau of Consumer Financial Protection; and

7            (2) supports the Bureau's ongoing mission by  
8        preserving the current management, oversight, and  
9        funding structure of the Bureau.
