

**MOTION TO RECOMMIT H.R. 2009, WITH  
INSTRUCTIONS  
OFFERED BY M. \_\_\_\_\_**

M. \_\_\_\_\_ moves to recommit the bill H.R. 2009 to the Committee on Ways and Means with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendment:

1 **SEC. 4. PROTECTING MIDDLE CLASS FAMILIES AND SMALL**  
2 **BUSINESSES FROM TAX INCREASES.**

3 Nothing in this Act shall be construed to alter, im-  
4 pact, delay, or weaken—

5 (1) section 1401 of the Patient Protection and  
6 Affordable Care Act that provides tax credits for  
7 middle class families (earning up to \$94,200 for a  
8 family of four) for the purchase of health insurance  
9 coverage in Exchanges; and

10 (2) section 1421 of the Patient Protection and  
11 Affordable Care Act that provides tax credits to  
12 small businesses (up to 50 percent of the cost of cov-  
13 erage for two years beginning in 2014; up to 35 per-  
14 cent for prior years) for the purchase of health in-  
15 surance coverage for employees.
