

**MOTION TO RECOMMIT H.R. 3362 WITH
INSTRUCTIONS
OFFERED BY M__ . _____**

M__ . _____ moves to recommit the bill H.R. 3362 to the Committee on Energy and Commerce with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendment:

Add at the end of the bill the following new section:

1 **SEC. 5. DISCLOSURE OF LOWER COSTS AND ADDITIONAL**
2 **HEALTH BENEFITS PROVIDED TO INDIVID-**
3 **UALS AND FAMILIES.**

4 Not later than 5 days after the date of the enactment
5 of this Act, and every month thereafter through March
6 2015, the Secretary of Health and Human Services shall
7 submit to Congress and make available to State governors,
8 State insurance commissioners, and the public a report
9 containing information, with respect to individuals and
10 families enrolling in health insurance coverage through an
11 Exchange established under title I of the Patient Protec-
12 tion and Affordable Care Act, on each of the following:

1 (1) The number of such individuals and families
2 who have received premium tax credits or have lower
3 out-of-pocket costs.

4 (2) The number of such individuals and families
5 who are no longer subject to discrimination based on
6 pre-existing conditions.

7 (3) The number of such individuals and families
8 who are no longer subject to annual and lifetime
9 limits on health insurance coverage.

10 (4) The number of such individuals and families
11 who were uninsured prior to enrolling in health in-
12 surance coverage through such an Exchange.

13 Nothing in this Act shall limit the ability of the Secretary
14 of Health and Human Services to inform individuals and
15 families of the lower costs for health insurance coverage
16 and additional benefits that are available pursuant to the
17 Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act and title I and
18 subtitle B of title II of the Health Care and Education
19 Reconciliation Act of 2010.
