CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Directing the Clerk of the House of Representatives to make
a correction in the enrollment of H.J. Res. 59.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),* That, in the enrollment of the joint resolution
3 (H.J. Res. 59) making continuing appropriations for fiscal
4 year 2014, and for other purposes, the Clerk of the House
5 of Representatives shall make the following correction: At
6 the end of the joint resolution (before the short title), in-
7 sert the following:

8 “SEC. 137. (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any
9 other provision of law, no Federal funds shall be made

1 available to carry out any provisions of the Patient Protec-
2 tion and Affordable Care Act (Public Law 111–148) or
3 title I and subtitle B of title II of the Health Care and
4 Education Reconciliation Act of 2010 (Public Law 111–
5 152), or of the amendments made by either such Act.

6 “(b) LIMITATION.—No entitlement to benefits under
7 any provision of the Patient Protection and Affordable
8 Care Act (Public Law 111–148) or title I and subtitle B
9 of title II of the Health Care and Education Reconciliation
10 Act of 2010 (Public Law 111–152), or the amendments
11 made by either such Act, shall remain in effect on and
12 after the date of the enactment of this Act, nor shall any
13 payment be awarded, owed, or made to any State, District,
14 or territory under any such provision.

15 “(c) UNOBLIGATED BALANCES.—Notwithstanding
16 any other provision of law, all unobligated balances avail-
17 able under the provisions of law referred to in subsection
18 (a) are hereby rescinded.”.
