2 migration. All points of order against consideration of the
3 bill are waived. The bill shall be considered as read. All

5 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
6 the bill and on any amendment thereto to final passage
7 without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate
8 equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking
9 minority member of the Committee on the Judiciary; and
10 (2) one motion to recommit.
