Page 9, after line 4, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2 This Act and the amendments made by this Act shall
3 take effect on the later of the following dates:

4 (1) The date on which all of the following have
5 been completed:

6 (A) The Commissioner of U.S. Customs
7 and Border Protection has conducted an eval-
8 uation and pilot program of the Test for Espio-
9 nage, Sabotage, and Corruption (TES-C).

10 (B) The Inspector General of the Depart-
11 ment of Homeland Security has certified such
12 evaluation and pilot program.

13 (C) The Commissioner submits to Con-
14 gress a report on such evaluation and pilot pro-
15 gram.

16 (2) The date on which the Inspector General of
17 the Department of Homeland Security completes a
18 risk assessment of the population of individuals who
19 could receive waivers under section 3(b) of the Anti-

1 Border Corruption Act of 2010, as amended by this
2 Act, and submits to Congress certification that pro-
3 viding waivers to such individuals would not endan-
4 ger national security, undermine workforce integrity,
5 or increase corruption.
