At the end of title V (page 194, after line 1), insert
the following new section:

1 **SEC. 5xx. COMPTROLLER GENERAL STUDY OF MILITARY**
2 **RECRUITING.**

3 (a) REPORT.—Not later than one year after the date
4 of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General shall
5 submit to the Committees on Armed Services of the Sen-
6 ate and House of Representatives a report on military re-
7 cruiting:

8 (b) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—The Comptroller
9 General shall include in the report the following:

10 (1) Whether military recruitment criminal viola-
11 tions have increased in any branches of the Armed
12 Forces since the beginning of combat in Iraq.

13 (2) Whether policies of the Department of De-
14 fense or of any of the specific military branches have
15 caused or encouraged military recruiters to carry out
16 criminal actions to increase recruitment numbers.

17 (3) Whether the Department of Justice, De-
18 partment of Defense, or specific military branches
19 have adequately and independently carried out inves-



1 tigungen and prosecutions of all Department of De-
2 fense officials who are complicit or directly involved
3 in criminal actions to increase military recruitment.

4 (4) Any recommendations for any legislation or
5 administrative actions that the Comptroller General
6 considers appropriate.

7 (5) Any other matter the Comptroller General
8 considers relevant.
