

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1401, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MRS. FOWLER OF FLORIDA**

At the end of title X (page 305, after line 5), insert
the following new section:

1 **SEC. 1040. REPORT ON AIRLIFT REQUIREMENTS TO SUP-**
2 **PORT NATIONAL MILITARY STRATEGY.**

3 (a) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than June 1,
4 2000, the Secretary of Defense shall submit to Congress
5 a report, in both classified and unclassified form, describ-
6 ing the airlift requirements necessary to execute the full
7 range of missions called for under the National Military
8 Strategy prescribed by the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs
9 of Staff under the postures of force engagement antici-
10 pated through 2015.

11 (b) CONTENT OF REPORT.—The report shall address
12 the following:

13 (1) The identity, size, structure, and capabili-
14 ties of the airlift requirements necessary for the full
15 range of shaping, preparing, and responding mis-
16 sions demanded under the National Military Strat-
17 egy.

18 (2) The required support and infrastructure re-
19 quired to successfully execute the full range of mis-
20 sions required under the National Military Strategy,

1 on the deployment schedules outlined in the plans of
2 the relevant commanders-in-chief from expected and
3 increasingly dispersed postures of engagement.

4 (3) The anticipated effect of enemy use of
5 weapons of mass destruction, other asymmetrical at-
6 tacks, expected rates of peacekeeping and other con-
7 tingency missions, and other similar factors on the
8 mobility force and its required infrastructure and on
9 mobility requirements.

10 (4) The effect on mobility requirements of new
11 service force structures, such as the Air Force's Air
12 Expeditionary Force and the Army's Strike Force,
13 and any foreseeable force structure modifications
14 through 2015.

15 (5) The need to deploy forces strategically and
16 employ them tactically using the same airlift plat-
17 form.

18 (6) The need for an increased airlift platform
19 capable of deploying outsize equipment or large vol-
20 umes of supplies and equipment.

21 (7) The anticipated role of host nation, foreign,
22 and coalition airlift support and requirements
23 through 2015.
