

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1401, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. GILMAN OF NEW YORK OR MR.
SPENCE OF SOUTH CAROLINA

At the end of title XII (page 317, after line 17), insert the following new section:

1 SEC. 1206. RESOURCES FOR EXPORT LICENSE FUNCTIONS.

2 (a) OFFICE OF DEFENSE TRADE CONTROLS.—

3 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of State shall
4 take the necessary steps to ensure that, in any fiscal
5 year, adequate resources are allocated to the func-
6 tions of the Office of Defense Trade Controls of the
7 Department of State relating to the review and proc-
8 essing of export license applications so as to ensure
9 that those functions are performed in a thorough
10 and timely manner.

11 (2) AVAILABILITY OF EXISTING APPROPRIA-
12 TIONS.—The Secretary of State shall take the nec-
13 essary steps to ensure that those funds made avail-
14 able under the heading “Administration of Foreign
15 Affairs, Diplomatic and Consular Programs” in title
16 IV of the Departments of Commerce, Justice, and
17 State, the Judiciary, and Related Agencies Appro-
18 priations Act, 1999, as contained in the Omnibus
19 Consolidated and Emergency Supplemental Appro-

1 priations Act, 1999 (Public Law 105-277) are made
2 available, upon the enactment of this Act, to the Of-
3 fice of Defense Trade Controls of the Department of
4 State to carry out the purposes of the Office.

5 (b) DEFENSE THREAT REDUCTION AGENCY.—The
6 Secretary of Defense shall take the necessary steps to en-
7 sure that, in any fiscal year, adequate resources are allo-
8 cated to the functions of the Defense Threat Reduction
9 Agency of the Department of Defense relating to the re-
10 view of export license applications so as to ensure that
11 those functions are performed in a thorough and timely
12 manner.
