

Amendment to H.R. 1501
Offered by Mr. Kucinich of Ohio

Page 3, strike lines 23 and 24, and insert the following:

1 “(9) establishing and maintaining an auto-
2 mated system of records relating to any adjudication
3 of juveniles less than 18 years of age who are adjud-
4 icated delinquent for conduct that would be a vio-
5 lent crime if committed by an adult, that—

6 “(A) is equivalent to the system of records
7 that would be kept of adults arrested for such
8 conduct, including fingerprint records and pho-
9 tograph records;

10 “(B) provides for submitting such juvenile
11 records to the Federal Bureau of Investigation
12 in the same manner as adult criminal records
13 are so submitted;

14 “(C) requires the retention of juvenile
15 records for a period of time that is equal to the
16 period of time for which adult criminal records
17 are retained; and

18 “(D) makes available, on an expedited
19 basis, to law enforcement agencies, to courts,

1 and to school officials who shall be subject to
2 the same standards and penalties that apply
3 under Federal and State law to law enforce-
4 ment and juvenile justice personnel with respect
5 to handling such records and disclosing infor-
6 mation contained in such records;
