

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1402, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. MANZULLO OF ILLINOIS**

Add at the end the following new section:

1 **SEC. ____.** **CONDITIONAL IMPLEMENTATION OF ACT.**

2 (a) **EFFECTIVE DATE; ROLE OF UNITED STATES**
3 **TRADE REPRESENTATIVE.**—This Act and the amend-
4 ments made by this Act shall take effect on the date of
5 the enactment of this Act, except that the Secretary of
6 Agriculture may not carry out this Act or implement any
7 amendment made by this Act unless and until the United
8 States Trade Representative notifies the Secretary that
9 this Act and the amendments made by this Act present
10 no risk of interference with any international trade nego-
11 tiation to which the United States is currently a party or
12 with the achievement of the trade policy objectives of the
13 United States.

14 (b) **CONTINUING ASSESSMENT OF EFFECT ON**
15 **TRADE.**—If this Act and the amendments made by this
16 Act are implemented as provided in subsection (a), the
17 United States Trade Representative shall periodically as-
18 sess the effect of the implementation of this Act and the
19 amendments made by this Act on international trade nego-
20 tiations to which the United States is a party and the
21 trade policy objectives of the United States.

1 (c) TERMINATION.—If, as a result of an assessment
2 under subsection (b), the United States Trade Representa-
3 tive determines that this Act or any amendment made by
4 this Act presents a risk of interference with any inter-
5 national trade negotiation to which the United States is
6 a party or with the achievement of the trade policy objec-
7 tives of the United States, the United States Trade Rep-
8 resentative shall notify the Secretary of Agriculture of the
9 determination. Upon receipt of the notification, the Sec-
10 retary shall cease to carry out this Act and amendments
11 made by this Act.
