

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1401, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. NEY OF OHIO

At the end of title XII (page 317, after line 17), insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 1206. ANNUAL REPORT ON MILITARY POWER OF THE**
2 **PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA.**

3 (a) ANNUAL REPORT.—The Secretary of Defense
4 shall prepare an annual report, in both classified and un-
5 classified form, on the current and future military strategy
6 and capabilities of the People's Republic of China. The
7 report shall address the current and probable future
8 course of military-technological development in the Peo-
9 ple's Liberation Army and the tenets and probable devel-
10 opment of Chinese grand strategy, security strategy, and
11 military strategy, and of military organizations and oper-
12 ational concepts, through 2020.

13 (b) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—The report shall
14 include analyses and forecasts of the following:

15 (1) The goals of Chinese grand strategy, secu-
16 rity strategy, and military strategy.

17 (2) Trends in Chinese political grand strategy
18 meant to establish the People's Republic of China as
19 the leading political power in the Asia-Pacific region

1 and as a political and military presence in other re-
2 gions of the world.

3 (3) The size, location, and capabilities of Chi-
4 nese strategic, land, sea, and air forces.

5 (4) Developments in Chinese military doctrine,
6 focusing on (but not limited to) efforts to exploit a
7 transformation in military affairs or to conduct pre-
8 emptive strikes.

9 (5) Efforts, including technology transfers and
10 espionage, by the People's Republic of China to de-
11 velop, acquire, or gain access to information, com-
12 munication, space, and other advanced technologies
13 that would enhance military capabilities.

14 (c) SUBMISSION OF REPORT.—The report under this
15 section shall be submitted to Congress not later than
16 March 15 each year.
