At the end of title XII (page 384, after line 3), insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. ____ . ASSISTANCE TO IRAQI CHILDREN INJURED DUR-**
2 **ING OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM.**

3 (a) ASSISTANCE.—The Secretary of Defense shall, to
4 the maximum extent practicable, provide all necessary
5 support in an expeditious manner to assist Iraqi children
6 who were injured during Operation Iraqi Freedom.

7 (b) ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS.—Assistance de-
8 scribed in subsection (a) may be provided to a child only
9 if adequate treatment from other sources in Iraq or neigh-
10 boring countries is not available and only after completion
11 of an evaluation by a physician or other appropriate med-
12 ical personnel of the United States Armed Forces. In addi-
13 tion, assistance described in subsection (a) may be pro-
14 vided only if it would not adversely affect military oper-
15 ations of the United States.

16 (c) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “Oper-
17 ation Iraqi Freedom” means operations of the United
18 States Armed Forces, the armed forces of the United
19 Kingdom, and the armed forces of other coalition member
20 countries initiated on or about March 19, 2003—



1 (1) to disarm Iraq of its weapons of mass de-
2 struction;

3 (2) to enforce United Nations Security Council
4 Resolution 1441 (November 8, 2002) and other rel-
5 evant Security Council resolutions with respect to
6 Iraq; and

7 (3) to liberate the people of Iraq from the re-
8 gime of Saddam Hussein.
