OFFERED BY MR. SMITH OF NEW JERSEY AND
MR. BARCIA

Page 19, strike line 1 and all that follows through line 17, on page 21, and insert the following:

1 (d) CONTRIBUTIONS TO UNITED NATIONS POPU-
2 LATION FUND.—

3 (1) LIMITATION.—Of the amounts made avail-
4 able under subsection (a) for United States vol-
5 untary contributions no funds may be made avail-
6 able to the United Nations Population Fund
7 (UNFPA) unless the President submits to the ap-
8 propriate congressional committees the certification
9 described in paragraph (2).

10 (2) CERTIFICATION.—The certification referred
11 to in paragraph (1) is a certification by the Presi-
12 dent that—

13 (A) the UNFPA has terminated all activi-
14 ties in the People's Republic of China, and the
15 United States has received assurances that
16 UNFPA will conduct no such activities during
17 the fiscal year for which the funds are to be
18 made available; or

1 (B) during the 12 months preceding such
2 certification there have been no abortions as the
3 result of coercion associated with the family
4 planning policies of the national government or
5 other governmental entities within the People's
6 Republic of China.

7 (C) DEFINITION.—As used in this sub-
8 section, the term “coercion” includes physical
9 duress or abuse, destruction or confiscation of
10 property, loss of means of livelihood, and severe
11 psychological pressure.
