

Amendment to H.R. 1501
Offered by Mr. Souder of Indiana

At the end of the bill, add the following (and make such technical and conforming changes as may be appropriate):

1 **SEC. 3. NONDISCRIMINATION BASED ON RELIGIOUS OR**
2 **MORAL BELIEFS.**

3 The Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act
4 of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 5601 et seq.) is amended by inserting
5 before title III the following:

6 “NONDISCRIMINATION BASED ON RELIGIOUS OR MORAL
7 BELIEFS

8 “SEC. 299J. None of the funds appropriated to carry
9 out this Act may be used, directly or indirectly, to dis-
10 criminate against, denigrate, or otherwise undermine the
11 religious or moral beliefs of juveniles who participate in
12 programs for which financial assistance is provided under
13 this Act or of the parents or legal guardians of such juve-
14 niles.”.
